GUIDELINES TO REGISTER FOR ADMISSIONS FROM CLASS-II to IX

- 1. **KVS Admission Guideline 2020-21** will be followed strictly for all Admissions and Reservations. https://www.kvsangathan.nic.in/academic/admission-guidelines
- 2. Reckoning of age for all Classes shall be as on 31.03.2020.
- 3. Mere Registration will not confer the right of admission.
- 4. Incomplete application forms shall **normally be rejected**.
- 5. Admission secured on the basis of any wrong certificate **shall be cancelled** by the Principal forthwith and no appeal against such action of the Principal shall be entertained.
- 6. Under present situation of COVID-19, the directions issued by Competent Authority (Central/State/Local) are to be followed. **Accordingly, the parents are requested not to visit Kendriya Vidyalaya CRPF Pallipuram physically to avoid gathering.**
- 7. All information regarding Admission, Registration form will be available on Vidyalaya website (https://crpfpallipuram.kvs.ac.in/academics/admission-detail).

- 9. Registration for admissions will be (offline) /E-mail mode based on availability of vacancies in a particular class.

- 12. <u>Before filling the Registration Form</u>, the **copy** of following documents shall be kept ready:

Documents required

- (a). Passport size photograph of the child (Mandatory).
- (b). Date of Birth certificate(Mandatory).
- (c). Present Residential Address Proof from local bodies (panchayath) / employer (for cat1 to cat4).
- (d). Caste category certificate on child's name (If applicable).
- (e). Service Certificate of the parent with number of transfers in the last 7 years, from the competent authority (If applicable).
- (f). Blood group certificate of the child
- (g). Aadhar card (Mandatory).
- (h). Disability Certificate from Civil Surgeon (If applicable).

- 13. After filling the registration form, check for any error, make the corrections, attach all the required files and scan it and send to the email admissionkypallipuram@gmail.com
- 14. Registration forms should reach the vidyalaya by email on or before 25.07.2020 (Saturday) till 04:00 pm.(The scanned copies must be clearly observable and readable. Use either flatbed scanner connected to computer OR any good document scanner App from mobile).
- 15. All the attached Document copies must be self-attested with date.
- 16. You are requested to keep the original application form with you for future reference.
- 17. Admission will be granted based on <u>Priority Category System (Cat. 1 to 5)</u> for vacancies available in a particular class.
- 18. If applications are more than the number of seats vacant, in a particular category and transfers, **lottery system will be followed.**
- 19. The student must have studied the subjects as per KVS / CBSE pattern: <u>English</u>, <u>Hindi</u>, <u>Sanskrit</u> (for class VI to VIII), <u>Mathematics</u>, <u>Environmental Science</u> (for class II to V) / Science and Social Science.
- 20. There will <u>NOT</u> be any admission test up to **class VIII**.
- 21. For Class IX, <u>admission test will be conducted</u> in English, Hindi, Math, Science and Social Science for 100 Marks (20 Marks each subject only one paper) and 3 hours. Candidates must secure 33% marks in aggregate to qualify. <u>Merit list will be prepared for each category of priority separately for admission.</u>
- 22. Forms received through email/post/by hand after the cut off date and time will not be entertained
- 23. <u>The schedule of admission process will be announced after completion of Registrations.</u>
